Guidelines for Recording Videos

Before you start

- You should save always keep a copy of the video for yourself
- 1. There is no expectation that you create professional quality productions. The use of titles, opening and closing credits etc. are best left to the professionals.
- 2. It is important however that the quality of the video be sufficient for the lecturers to assess and understand.
- 3. As a general rule of thumb it is important that the sound on your device is working and is of good sound quality so sound checks are vital before recording begins.
- 4. Please ensure that the video is of good quality.
- 5. The video should be continuous and there should be no interruptions.
- 6. The student needs to be visible and their voice needs to be audible.
- 7. Students should start with an outline of what they are going to present (i.e their main points).
- 8. The presentation should be no more than 10 minutes long
- 9. There should be a minimum of 8 slides.
