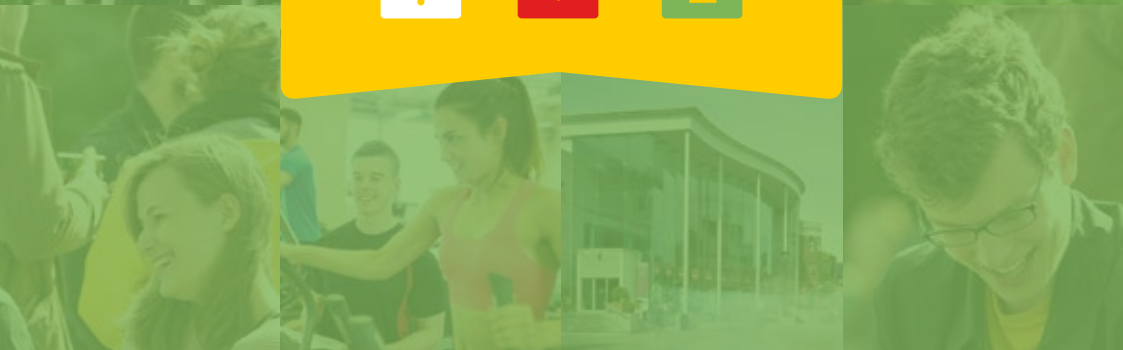

ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

UCC OWNED CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION

There are four complexes available to first year students in Campus Accommodation

- **Victoria Lodge** • **Victoria Mills** • **Castlewhite**
- **Mardyke Hall** • **Áras Uí Thuama**

APPLICATIONS FOR CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION

- You must live over 45km from UCC
- Applications open for one month only (normally Feb - March each year)
- Applications received are included in a **Random Selection Lottery**

RECOMMENDATIONS

Because places are not guaranteed in Campus Accommodation, we suggest that all students also search for an alternative source of accommodation as a backup.



PRIVATELY OWNED STUDENT APARTMENT COMPLEXES

- These complexes have a similar model to Campus Accommodation, but prices can vary considerably.
- There are over 4,000 beds in privately owned student apartment complexes throughout Cork City

PRIVATE RENTALS

- Defined as house shares with other students
- Monthly rental costs may vary considerably based on standard and/or distance from UCC

DIGS (OWNER OCCUPIED HOUSING)

- Living with home owner/family
- May be subject to a rental period of 5 or 7 days per week
- May include meals and/or bills
