University College Cork invites applications for its
full-time professional Master of Social Work course.

The Master of Social Work (MSW) is a two year full-time professional training course open to graduates with a minimum second-class honours BSocSc level 8 degree or equivalent (e.g Level 8 BA in Social Care/Social Policy). Graduates without a second-class honours degree may enter the first year of the Postgraduate Diploma in Social Work Studies and may transfer into the MSW programme in year 2. On successful completion of the MSW/PGDSWS you will be eligible to apply for registration as a social worker with the Health and Social Care Professionals Council (www.coru.ie).

Practice placements are an integral part of this programme. Successful candidates, except those with family responsibilities, will be required to move outside Cork for at least one of their placements. All successful candidates will be Garda vetted prior to going on placement.

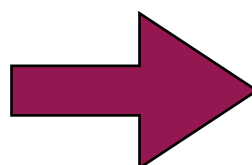
