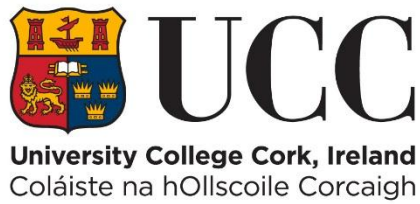

Standards for Network Points

When connecting to the campus LAN it is important that users observe the following rules to ensure that they do not adversely affect the network service for themselves or others.

1. Users must follow the Acceptable Use Policy.
2. Wall boxes must not be modified, moved or damaged in any way
3. Only a single workstation *or* network printer should be connected to each point and then only provided
 - it (and any cables) comply with IEEE 802.3/Computer Centre standards
 - it uses only addresses explicitly supplied by the Computer Centre
 - it does not run any network protocols except those authorised by the Computer Centre
4. Users must not connect network equipment or by any other means allow for the connection of more than one device to any network point without prior agreement with the Computer Centre
5. Users should ensure that the above are followed by any third parties (contractors, suppliers etc.) acting on their behalf.
6. There are additional requirements in Standard for Connecting Equipment to the UCC Network which must also be observed.
