Eligible Programmes for Direct Entry to the MSW and PDSWS programmes at UCC

The following programmes have been deemed to be equivalent to the Bachelor of Social Science (BSocSc) at UCC for purposes of being eligible to apply **directly** to study for the Master of Social Work (2H1 or higher) or the Postgraduate Diploma in Social Work Studies (PDSWS, pass or 2H2 grade in your degree).

While this list is not exhaustive, it is important to note that requests for equivalency applications MUST be completed by the School of Applied Social Studies to the College of CACSSS for candidates without a Bachelor of Social Science (BSocSc), BA Hons in Social Care, or a Higher Diploma in Social Policy/Social Studies or one of the approved programmes listed below. For example, applicants with undergraduate social work programmes (e.g. BSW) from other countries **can apply directly**, but an equivalence check must be undertaken if your application is successful.

If your programme is not listed, you may still be able to apply to the PDSWS programme under the Recognition of Prior Learning pathway (RPL). See www.ucc.ie/en/msw for further information on eligibility criteria for the RPL pathway.
