

ARCHAEOLOGY TEACHING AND COVID-19 ACADEMIC YEAR 2020/21

Archaeology is committed to delivering as much teaching on campus as possible in the prevailing pandemic circumstances, always subject to public health guidelines. Lectures commence on **Monday, 28th September 2020**. Our BA courses will have a mix of face-to-face teaching with the full class in attendance, or else face-to-face teaching with staggered attendance (class split into groups who will attend lectures in classrooms and online on alternate days each week). Most Archaeology modules in Second and Third Year have small class sizes, and so we are hoping for 100% classroom delivery. We will double-teach our larger First Year class to meet social distancing requirements. All lectures will be recorded, and these will be available online for students who have health concerns, are registered with DSS or are unable attend classrooms. Class timetable information will be available once you register for individual modules in September.

DEPARTMENT OF ARCHAEOLOGY DETAILS OF UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING, 2020/21

The following are timetable details of teaching in Archaeology for the coming academic year. This is based on current social distancing guidelines (1m with face-coverings in class), which are subject to change in prevailing pandemic circumstances and public health guidelines. Full details will be available on CANVAS module pages after registration, and in course year booklets that will be emailed to all students in late September.

IMPORTANT: Delivery of Teaching

Depending on final class size, which will not be known until registration is complete, students will have 100%, 75% or a minimum of 50% face-to-face teaching in Archaeology. Only one module will be delivered entirely online (second year module AR2047). The timetable for Second and Third Year Archaeology will depend to a large extent on the option modules you choose.
