

Accommodation near University College Cork

University College Cork is located 1km from the centre of Cork City. There are many options for visitors to stay in the city centre; nearer the university itself, the following accommodation is frequently used by visitors:

Affordable modern accommodation provided by the university, most of which is situated on or next to the campus (check on the maps provided on the website for details).

Affordable Bed and Breakfast accommodation right beside the university, offering a speciality breakfast. Many college departments use this as their default location for visiting speakers.

A large modern hotel with attractive views over the river Lee, situated in close proximity to the university and widely used by visiting academics and conferences.

A small hotel located very close to the university on the way into Cork City, comfortable and accessible for short stays.

A large modern hotel situated close to the university, en route towards West Cork. The hotel hosts conferences and offers high class facilities.
