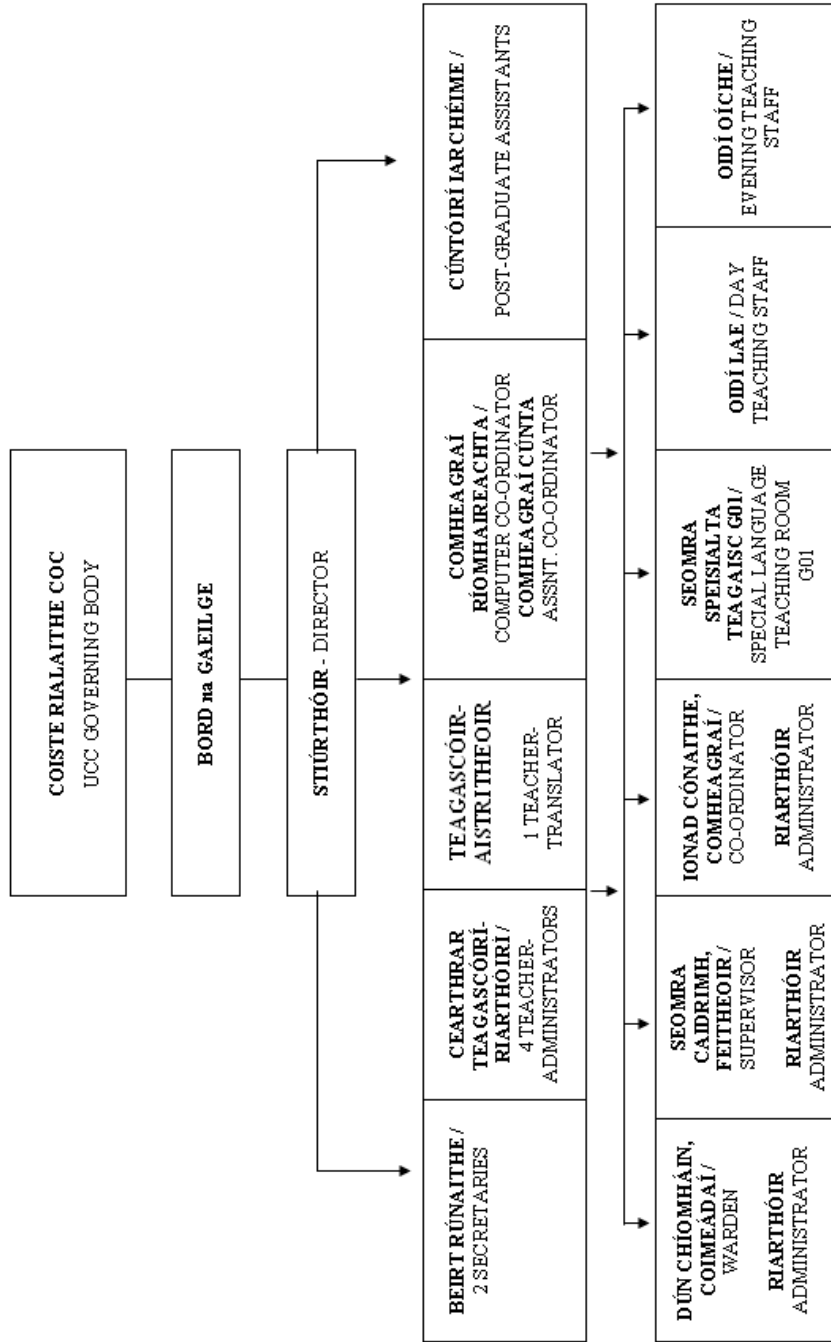

1.1 Comhthéacs

Tá téarmaí tagartha Bhord na Gaeilge leagtha síos i staitiúidí XCV agus CXL de chuid Staitiúidí Choláiste na hOllscoile Corcaigh. Is coiste staitiúideach é An Bord de chuid an Choiste Rialaithe. Ghlac Coiste Rialaithe COC leis an gcáipéis pholasaí de chuid an Bhoird “*Cur chun cinn na Gaeilge i saol an Choláiste*” ar 23 Aibreán 1996. Bunaíodh spriocráiteas an Ionaid ar an ndoiciméad céanna polasaí. Tá ceithre mhír aidhme sa spriocráiteas mar atá :

- *an Ghaeilge a chur chun cinn go cruthaitheach in COC agus in Éirinn faoi réir ag airteagal 8 de Bhunreacht na hÉireann (1937), ag Acht na nOllscol (1997), ag Acht na dTeangacha (2003) agus ag Comhaontú Bhéal Feirste (1998)*
- *cláir teanga sa Ghaeilge labhartha agus fheidhmeach a thairiscint ag an uile leibhéal líofachta san ollscoil agus ag na leibhéil chuí sa Ghaeltacht i gcomhthéacs ollscoil na Gaeilge*
- *cur ar chumas daoine bheith páirteach i dtimpeallacht thacúil, dhátheangach a bhfuil scéimeanna agus gréasáin Ghaeilge agus gníomhaíochtaí cultúrtha mar chuid di*
- *a chinntiú go dtagann na seirbhísí teanga uile faoi anáil taighde agus na gcleachtas is fearr i réimse leathan an tsealbhaithe teanga*

1.2 Buai ceanna na bliana - Achoimre

- Mhéadaigh líon na mac léinn a d'fhreastail ar chláir teanga in Ionad na Gaeilge Labhartha go dtí 1835. Méadú de 12.5% ar líon na bliana roimhe sin atá i gceist. Tá méadú faoi dhó déanta ar líon na mac léinn ón mbliain 2000 i leith (932).
- Mhéadaigh líon na mac léinn a d'fhreastail ar scéimeanna agus ar ghníomhaíochtaí teanga an Ionaid faoi 10.5% mar a bhí 1509. Idir scéimeanna agus chúrsaí bhí 3669 ar fad sa treis, figiúr a léirigh méadú iomlán de 11.5% ar líon na bliana 2004 – 2005 (3292). Is ionann 3669 agus 24% de líon iomlán na mac léinn a fhreastalaíonn ar Choláiste na hOllscoile Corcaigh.
- Cuireadh i bhfearas 63 ghrúpa foghlama lae, 24 ghrúpa foghlama oíche agus cúig cinn de chúrsaí speisialta. Ba é líon iomlán na ngrúpaí foghlama teanga 92. Múineadh seacht gcinn eile breise sna Ranna Gaeilge.
- Ceapadh fiche múinteoir páirtaimseartha agus naonúr aoichainteoirí chun dualgais teagais an ochtair foirne lánaimseartha a chomhlánú. Ghlac fiche aoichainteoir páirt sna seacht gcúrsa is fiche a eagraíodh i nDún Chíomhain i gcaitheamh na bliana.
- D'éirigh ar fheabhas chomh maith leis na scéimeanna agus leis na gníomhaíochtaí sin atá go hiomlán faoi choimirce Bhord na Gaeilge :

Mhéadaigh líon na rannpháirtithe faoi 10.5% ón mbliain roimhe sin.

- Ghlac Bord na Gaeilge le uiríoll cuimsitheach agus le struchtúr a bhainfeadh le bunú an tionscnaimh “Ollscoil na Gaeilge”. Pléadh an t-uiríoll i ngach ceann de na ceithre Choláiste san Ollscoil agus do ghlacadar ar fad leis. Tá an t-uiríoll á phlé ag an gCoiste Rialaithe faoi láthair (Deireadh Fómhair 2006).
- Ar 13 Meitheamh 2005, ghlac Comhairle na nAirí san Aontas Eorpach leis an nGaeilge mar theanga oifigiúil oibre agus tiocfaidh an moladh i bhfeidhm ar 2 Eanáir 2007. Tháinig Acht na dTeangacha Oifigiúla go hiomlán i bhfeidhm ar 14 Iúil 2006 agus faoi réir ag téarmaí an Achta, d’ullmhaigh meitheal COC um Acht na dTeangacha scéim teanga thrí bliana a leagann amach na céimeanna is gá chun seirbhís dhátheangach bhunúsach a chur ar fáil do mhic léinn agus don phobal.
- Ghlac Bord na Gaeilge le plan forbartha straitéiseach Ionad na Gaeilge Labhartha. Meastar sa phlean go méadóidh líon na bhfoghlaimeoirí ó 1600 go dtí 2100 is é sin faoi 30% sa tréimhse 2005 – 2010. Cuireadh an plan ar aghaidh go dtí Oifig an Chothaithe Feabhais agus go dtí Coláiste an ACSSS.
- Dearadh agus cuireadh ar fáil modúl nua d’fhíorthosnaitheoirí mic léinn i gColáiste an Leighis. Thosnaigh mionphleanáil ar thrí cinn de chúrsaí teastais agus dioplóma ar thug Coláiste an ACSSS cead imlíneach dóibh cheana. Sheol an Leas-Uachtarán Áine Hyland suíomh athdeartha an Ionaid agus an Bhoird, agus suíomh nua dátheangach na hollscoile ar 18 Samhain 2005.
- Faomhaíodh agus líonadh trí phost teagaise san Ionad. Faomhaíodh post nua eile mar theagascóir – bainisteoir i nDún Chíomháin. Tá an próiseas earcaíochta ar siúl i gcónaí (Deireadh Fómhair 2006).
- Bronnadh an duais bhliantúil ‘*Gradam na Gaeilge*’ atá faoi choimirce Bhanc na hÉireann agus ar fiú anois €1,000 í, ar Niamh Ní Ghrífin agus ar Laura Ní Chearbhaill ar an 26 Aibreán 2006. Mheas coiste na duaise go mba iad sin an bheirt mhac léinn ab éifeachtaí a chuir an teanga chun cinn i gcaitheamh na bliana acadúla.
- Bhí éileamh ard leanúnach ar an tseirbhís nua aistriúcháin i gcaitheamh na bliana agus d’éirigh léi teacht isteach de 18000 úró a ghnóthú.
- Chun ardfhiúntas na hoibre a aithint agus chun cur le neartú na Gaeilge san ollscoil, bheartaigh an tÚdarás um Ard-Oideachas ar dheontas de luach €255,000 a chur ar fáil. Cabhróidh an deontas le obair an Ionaid, le seirbhísí Gaeilge Áras na Mac Léinn, le foilsiú téacsleabhar Gaeilge, le tionscnamh an Léinn Dúchais Leictreonaigh (LDL) agus le maoiniú modúil nua dar teideal “*An Ghaeilge agus An Ceol*”.

TUARASCÁIL BHLIANTÚIL 2005 – 2006

1.1 Context

The terms of reference of Bord na Gaeilge are those as laid down in statutes XCV and CXL of the Statutes of University College Cork. Bord na Gaeilge functions as a statutory committee of UCC Governing Body. The policy document “*The advancement of Irish in College*” was prepared by Bord na Gaeilge and approved by UCC Governing Body 23 April 1996. The mission statement of Ionad na Gaeilge Labhartha is based on the policy document and contains four main objectives :

- (i) *to promote Irish creatively in UCC and in Ireland in accordance with article 8, The Irish Constitution (1937), provisions of the Universities Act (1997), the Official Languages Act (2003), The Belfast Agreement (1998)*
- (ii) *to offer spoken and applied Irish language programmes to learners at all fluency levels in UCC and at appropriate levels in An Ghaeltacht in the context of the “Ollscoil na Gaeilge” project*
- (iii) *to enable active participation in a supportive bilingual environment which includes Irish language networks, schemes and cultural activities*
- (iv) *to ensure that all services be informed by authoritative research and guided by good practice in the broad process of language acquisition and learning.*

1.2 The year’s main achievements - summary

- The core student number attending language programmes in Ionad na Gaeilge Labhartha increased to 1835. This figure indicates an increase of 12.5% on the previous year’s figure. Learner numbers doubled in An tIonad since 2000 – 2001 when 932 learners attended programmes.
- The number of students participating in language schemes and activities increased by 10.5% to 1509. The total student cohort attending both language schemes and language programmes reached the overall figure of 3669, which total indicates an increase of 11.5% on the 2004 – 2005 number (3292). The total of 3669 is equivalent to 24% of the total student cohort attending programmes in the university as a whole.
- Sixty-three day learners groups were formed, twenty-four evening groups and five special courses. The total number of learner groups was ninety-two while seven extra groups were taught in the two departments of Irish.
- Twenty part-time teachers and nine guest lecturers were appointed to supplement the teaching duties of eight full-time staff. Twenty guest speakers contributed to

the twenty-seven courses which were organised in Dún Chíomhain during the year.

- Language schemes and activities coming directly under the aegis of Bord na Gaeilge were very successful as the following participant numbers show :

The overall annual percentage increase was of the order of 10.5%.

- Bord na Gaeilge approved a submission relating to the setting up of the 'Ollscoil na Gaeilge' project. The submission was discussed and approved by each of the four Colleges. The submission has now (October 2006) been sent to the Governing Body for its approval in due course.
- On 13 June 2005, the EU Council of Ministers decided to proceed to adopt Irish as official working language of the EU. The decision comes into effect 2 January 2007. The Official Languages Act came fully into effect 14 July 2006. In accordance with the terms of the Act, the UCC official languages group prepared a three year language scheme which sets out the initial steps necessary for the provision of a basic bilingual service by the university to students and to members of the public.
- Bord na Gaeilge approved a five year strategic development plan (2005 – 2010) for Ionad na Gaeilge Labhartha. It is envisaged that student numbers will increase by 30% from 1600 to 2100 in the five year period. The plan was forwarded to the Quality Promotion Office and to the College of ACSSS.
- A new module for 'ab initio' learners of Irish in the College of Medicine was designed and offered. Outline planning permission was secured in regard to a number of certificate and diploma programmes and detailed preparation was initiated. Vice-President Áine Hyland launched the redesigned Ionad and Board website and the new central bilingual website of the university on 18 November 2005.
- Three teaching posts were approved and filled in An tIonad. The post of teacher – manager in Dún Chíomhain was also approved and is in the process of being filled (October 2006).
- The annual prize which is awarded to those students who are most effective in the promotion of Irish during the year, is called '*Gradam na Gaeilge*' and is sponsored to value of €1000 by the Bank of Ireland. The two recipients of the prize were Niamh Ní Ghrifín and Laura Ní Chearbhaill.

- Demand for the new translation service was substantial. It succeeded in generating in its first year an income of €18000.
- In recognition of the significant progress made and in order to further strengthen the programme for language promotion, the Higher Education Authority approved the granting of a subvention of €255K. This financial award will assist the work of An tIonad, the bilingual services of Áras na Mac Léinn, the publication of Irish language textbooks, the Léann Dúchais Leictreonach (LDL) project and the establishment of a new academic module entitled “*Music and the Irish Language*”.

Marketing and Public Relations

High priority was accorded to the exercise of targeted public relations and programme marketing. Such an approach assisted in ensuring brisk take up of language courses and in attracting much needed external funding (Roinn na Gaeltachta, Higher

Education Authority). The production of a short promotional video on the work of An tIonad gave added impetus to the publicity campaign.

An tIonad was to the forefront in furthering the work of the UCC lecturing skills programme and of the UCC Blackboard Users' Group.

Meetings were held regularly with national and international state and voluntary committees in relation to Irish language and minority language advancement. Interviews were accorded to and important assistance was accorded by radio and TV stations such as TG4, RTÉ 1, 96FM, Raidió na Gaeltachta, BBC, UCC Radio Campus. Speakers were nominated for Raidió na Gaeltachta news and TG4 news. Articles in both Irish and English were published in numerous newspapers and journals (*Saol, Feasta, Foinse, Lá, Graduate Review, College News, Irish Times, Sunday Tribune, Irish Examiner, Sunday Independent*).

An tIonad's own internal newsletter "*Bhuel*", was issued continually throughout the year and was distributed to students and staff.

Following consultation with the Office of Marketing and Communications, the new UCC website was relaunched as a bilingual website and is available in its new format since 18 November 2005. The Ionad website was itself redesigned and recast at the end of the year under review.
