

INTERMEDIATE (Level B1)

This course is primarily designed for those who have taken our 'False Beginners' course and it will take up where that course left off last year. Students who wish to join this course should be able to hold a conversation about themselves, their family, profession, habits, past experience, plans for the future, feelings and opinions on elementary subjects, although these will be revised.

The course is textbook based and is devised to consolidate existing knowledge, widening the students' ability to interact: speak, understand, read and write on various topics.

This course aims at reaching Level B1 of the Common European Framework.

At the end of the course, the students will have the option of taking the examination for the CILS (Certificate of Italian as a Foreign Language) at an appropriate level (decided in consultation with the teacher), issued by the Università per Stranieri di Siena (<https://cils.unistrasi.it/home.asp>) of which the Italian department at UCC is an outreach centre.
