For English Language Teachers (TEFL/TESOL) and for those for whom English is a Medium of Instruction (E.M.I) such as teachers and lecturers in third-level institutions and teachers in both primary and secondary schools.

What accommodation options are there?

What is minimum entry language level required?

Participants should normally have an upper-intermediate standard of English (**B2** on the Common European Framework).
