Pat and Matthew, Language Centre Hosts in Cork Homestay accommodation is when a student stays with a local family. Staying with an Irish host allows students to experience the Irish way of life in a friendly environment while practising their English. Our hosts are carefully selected and monitored. The cost for this accommodation is €240 per week and this includes:

- Bed, breakfast and evening meal Monday to Friday with full board at weekends
- Free collection and drop-off service from/to <u>Cork Airport</u>, <u>Cork Train Station</u>, Cork Bus Station and the <u>Aircoach</u> (direct from/to Dublin Airport) drop-off/collection point in Cork city centre, subject to times and availability of host transport
- Dedicated Host Family Co-ordinator to match student to host family using a detailed family application form
- Connection established between host family and student before student leaves their own home





Self-Catering Apartments

For students who prefer to live independently, we can arrange accommodation for you in one of the following three campus accommodation complexes: Victoria <u>Mills, Victoria Lodge or Castlewhite</u> apartments. All are only a short walk away from UCC and this option allows you the opportunity to mix with other students while studying in Cork.
