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Beyond the Teaching Laboratory - Practical Classes and Online Learning

Delivering practical classes in science, engineering and many other disciplines under the current restrictions presents significant problems. Whilst many lecturers have long used blended learning approaches where appropriate, in many courses there remained a significant practical element, delivered face-to-face and often reliant on hardware or other specialist resources that could not easily be made available to those learning remotely. The need to move all teaching online has forced many of us to re-think not only the content and delivery of practical classes, but also their role and purpose. In this talk I will present some observations based on recent experiences, and discuss some approaches which may help us retain some of the benefits of face-to-face practical classes as we move online.
