The MSc in Industrial Pharmaceutical Sciences, Operations and Management is a full-time **INTENSIVE** one year taught master's. This taught MSc includes an integrated 8-month industrial placement in semester 2 and 3 at a placement provider within the biopharma or pharma industry. The programme has been designed with industry, for industry, ensuring high employability on graduation.



The Industrial Pharmaceutical Sciences, Operations & Management MSc programme is the only one of its kind in Ireland and has a number of benefits.



Prior industrial experience is considered the most relevant factor in determining employability for new graduates in the marketplace. As part of this programme, you will undertake an industrial placement providing you with invaluable experience when applying for graduate roles in the biopharma and pharma industry.









The MSc in Industrial Pharmaceutical Sciences, Operations and Management is an intensive 12-month full time programme. Semester 1 is based on campus and is taught through lectures, workshops and practicals. The programme timetable has been designed to facilitate those commuting significant distances.

Students undertake their industry-based placement in semester 2 and 3, with two days per month based on campus for in-person workshops in semester 2.

Continuous assessment is the sole form of module assessment and will be performed through MCQs, assignments, group projects and presentations.

All applicants whose first language is not English are expected to have a minimum IELTS score of 6.5 with no individual section lower than 6.0.

FEES AND COSTS

EU students: €10,630

Non-EU students: €18,500

This includes all bench fees, equipment costs and field trips. While on placement, students will be expected to be on campus 1-2 days per month
