I attended the joint conference of the Specialist Registrars in Restorative Dentistry Group, Restorative Dentistry Consultants Group and European College of Gerodontology on the above date. I am currently working as a Clinical Research Fellow in Cork University Dental School and Hospital. My area of research interest is dental implants and I attended a workshop at the conference entitled "Digital Planning Strategies in Dentistry" to aid with my research.
