


BOYS raced through the streets of Bantry on Shrove Tuesday dragging old buckets, pots, pans, etc. and a bath in which were blazing old car tyres. Each group were called after the area they represented, viz.: Barrack Road Skelligs, The Quay Skelligs, Mill Rock Skelligs, etc. As they ran they periodically cried out "Will you come to the Skelligs." The boys were re-enacting the age-old custom linking up ending of Shrovetide, the traditional match-making and marrying period in rural Ireland and the famous Skellig Rock in Co. Kerry. 
