

Some Projects, Programmes and Achievements

- Reductions in Electricity, Gas and Water Consumption
- "Switch it OFF" campaign, Energy update emails
- Reduced Waste through much higher Recycling Rate
- Less Car Use, doubling of Cycling share among UCC Staff
- Car Pooling, Car Sharing (*GoCar*), Tax Saver PT Passes, CampusBike, "Cycle-to-Work", UCC Park+Ride...
- Polytunnels Community Garden
- Carbon Footprint Study (incl. commuting), ISO 50001 awarded
- UCC 3rd in Universities World Green Metrics, Green Award, ...

Potential topics for Research projects, student projects, etc ...

Car Sharing, Lift Sharing, Bike Sharing:

Sharing of Mobility services saves money, land use and emissions ... but include a degree of coordination and dependency

What are success factors, limitations of acceptance? Are there psychological barriers for Sharing instead of Owning (e.g. a car)?

Recycling / Paper consumption

Use of recycled printing paper seems to be rare, notebooks of recycled paper aren't offered in Campus shops.

What are limiting factors for the use of recycling paper? Where is paper being recycled in Ireland? Would procurement of recycling paper result in longer transport (more emissions)?

Energy Supply

"Seems it always rains in southern ..." – really? Potential of solar panel (PV) or wind power generation on Campus and in Homes


What's the actual potential, can it replace fossil power plants? Can e-Car batteries serve as de-centralised storage buffers?

Energy Consumption

Landlords are required to provide BER rating for their student houses if listed in UCC. Did it affect students' rental choices? Are houses being retrofitted as a result?

Use of Grey Water / Rain Water Harvesting

What would the cost benefit ratio be e.g. for toilet flushing (newly built / retrofit)?
