This Imagining2050 workshop was carried with local community representatives from Dingle Peninsula, on the 27 November 2020. 3. MORE TANGIBLE OUTCOMES

- Managing community expectation concerning outcomes from 'engaging' in research-focused events;
- What value is assigned to contributions in research contexts?
- Further direction and resources in mainstreaming deliberative bottom-up processes;
