About: The theme for 2023 is "Development/establishment of innovative and meaningful PPI partnerships". The aim is to develop/establish projects that address foundational work in PPI activities required to foster principles of trust, respect, flexibility, transparency, empowerment and power sharing, collaboration and partnership, and equality and inclusion.

Examples*

- Innovative ways to build meaningful relationships for impactful research.
- Projects that focus on early PPI involvement in research projects.
- Innovative projects that address power dynamics in PPI activities.
- New ways to partner and collaborate with individual and/or organisational PPI contributors.
- Innovative approaches to inclusion of seldom heard voices and marginalized groups in PPI activities.

*Please note these examples are not exhaustive or prescriptive and we welcome all types of applications that fit the theme and criteria for the seed funding call.







Essential Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Applications must have at least one PPI contributor and/or organisation engaged in PPI as co-applicant(s)
- Applications must have at least one UCC staff member as co-applicant (Please note that non-permanent academic primary applicants must have a contract end date beyond the end of the award)
- 3. Applications from PPI Ignite Network @ UCC local PPI partners are strongly encouraged (see list below)
- 4. Applications must include stated deliverables, achievable within the timeframe.
- 5. Projects must be conducted within the Republic of Ireland.
- 6. Projects must be completed within 12 months of the awarding date.
- 7. Applications must articulate the expected impact of the project.
- Successful applicants must provide an end of project impact case study within
 3 months of the project close date.
- 9. Successful awardees will be invited to partake in a seminar highlighting the outcome and impact of projects post project close.
- 10. Impact case studies are expected, where possible, to be open source or open access for use and knowledge exchange within the wider community.
- 11. PPI Ignite Network @ UCC must be acknowledged on all project outputs.
- 12. Applicants should consult and comply with the UCC PPI <u>budgeting in</u> <u>research</u> and payment policy guidelines.
