This is where participants photograph their community's strengths and needs regarding a societal issue, critically analyse the photographs and then present the photographs alongside written captions at a public exhibit. The idea is to use photographs to inform other members of their community and policymakers about the issues documented. It is a highly effective method of enabling individuals and communities to represent themselves, develop tools for advocacy and communication, and enact positive social change. The workshop format will be very friendly and focused on practical ways you can use what is learned.
