Deadline for submission for *BÉASCNA 9*

1 November 2013

Incomplete submissions will not be considered

Articles

- Maximum 5,000 words including endnotes
- Articles in Irish or English welcome
- An abstract in English must be provided (100-200 words) for all submissions, whether the article is in Irish or in English
- Reference by parenthetical citations in the body of the text with a separate Bibliography (See 'Style' below)
- Use endnotes not footnotes
- Keep endnotes to a minimum, and use only for significant commentary
- Include a bibliography at the end of the article of all references cited (See 'Biographical Style' below)
- Please contact editors as regards illustrations or photographs

Book reviews

- Maximum 2,000 words, in Irish or English

All Submissions

- Please submit by email attachment with document saved in Microsoft Word (.doc or .docx)
- Begin submission with a separate title page. On the title page: please give your name, email address, postal address, telephone number and a brief biographical note (e.g. institutions attended, research interests, other publications) to appear at the end of the article

Style

- Spacing: 1.5
- Font: Times New Roman 12 pt.
- Provide parenthetical internal citations following the Chicago Manual of Style, Author-Date iteration. Place full-stops after parenthetical citation, e.g. 'Quote' (Chandler 2001, 24)
- In the case of translated work please include the name of the translator
- We encourage the use of internal sub-headings within the article (rather than section numbers etc.). Please place sub-heading in Times New Roman, 13 pt., Bold
- Please format dates as Date Month Year, e.g., 27 September 2010

Altanna

- Uasmhéid 5,000 focal, nótaí deiridh san áireamh
- Aon alt a sheoltar chugainn, caithfidh achoimre Béarla (100-200 focal) a bheith leis, bíodh an t-alt féin i nGaeilge nó i mBéarla
- Ní mór tagairtí inmheánacha, idir lúibíní, a úsáid san alt (feic ‘Cúrsaí Stíle’ thíos)
- Is ceart nótaí deiridh a úsáid seachas fo-nótaí
- Bítear spárálach, más féidir, leis na nótaí deiridh
- Cuirtear i ndeireadh an ailt liosta de na saothair a ndéantar tagairt dóibh (feic ‘Córas Tagartha’ thíos)
- Is cóir teagmháil a dhéanamh leis na heagarthóirí má tá léaráidí nó grianghrafanna ag gabháil leis an alt

Léirmheasanna

- Uasmhéid 2,000 focal

Altanna/Léirmheasanna

- Seoltar an leagan deireanach chugainn i bhfoirm cheanglatán ríomhphoist, .i. comhad *Microsoft Word* (.doc nó .docx)
- Ba chóir go mbeadh leathanach teidil ar leith ag dul leis an alt nó leis an léirmheas. Cuirtear na sonraí seo a leanas ar an leathanach teidil: ainm agus sloinne an údair; seoladh ríomhphoist; seoladh poist; uimhir ghutháin agus nóta gearr beathaisnéise (.i. na hinstitiúidí ar fhreastail an t-údar orthu, na réimsí taighde is suim leis, foilsíúcháin eile dá chuid, etc.)

Cúrsaí Stíle

- Spásáil: 1.5
- Cló: ‘Times New Roman’ 12 pt.
- Is ceart tagairtí inmheánacha, idir lúbíní, a úsáid, ina bhfuil an t-údar, an dáta agus uimhir an leathanaigh tugtha, mar leanas: (Chandler 2001, 24)
- Is cóir ainm an aistritheora a lua i gcás aon tsaothair aistrithe a ndéantar tagairt dó
- Moltar do scríbhneoirí fotheidil a úsáid san alt in ionad uimhreacha a chur ar ranna. Is ceart aon fhotheidil atá san alt a chur i gcló ‘Times New Roman’ 13 pt., cló trom
- Is cóir dátaí a thabhairt mar leanas: 27 Meán Fómhair 2010 (Lá Mí Bliain)
