2021 United Nations Climate Change Conference



Resolution adopted by the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) in UCC on 26 October 2021

Addressing Climate Targets:

Sponsors: China, European Union, India, Other Developed Nations, Other Developing Nations, United States of America.

Recognising our common burden in alleviating the worst effects of climate change and the world's commitment to overcoming it together,

Understanding the importance of limiting global warming to 1.5 degrees,

Reaffirming our commitment to achieving the 17 Sustainable Development Goals,

The Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change,

Declares that the contribution to the Green Climate Fund must be proportionate to the historical emissions of each country and that the allocation of funds is dependent upon the needs of each country,

Calls on the leadership of all countries, particularly developed countries to ensure that all emission reduction pledges are adhered to and adequately respected,

Guarantees the provision of mutual support and prosperity for all nations.

Adopted on this day 26/10/2021 in UCC, Cork, Ireland.
