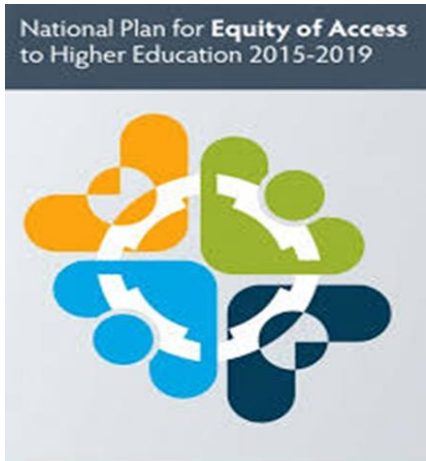

The target groups include the following:

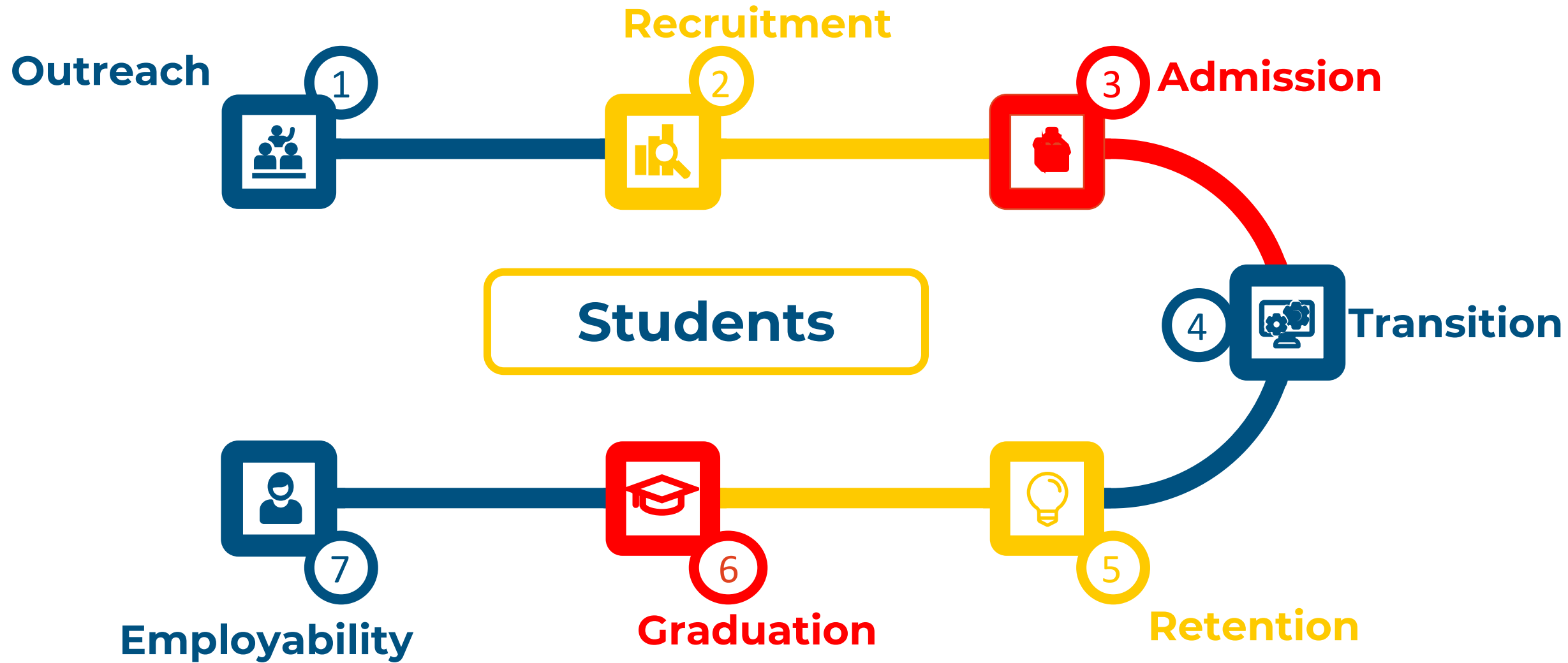
- Entrants from socio-economic groups that have low participation in higher education.

22% of Undergraduate Admissions in 21/22 via Access Routes

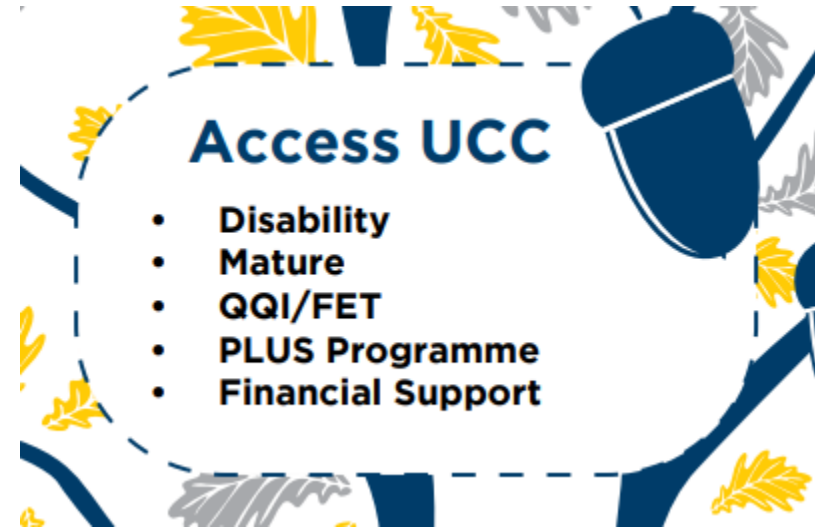

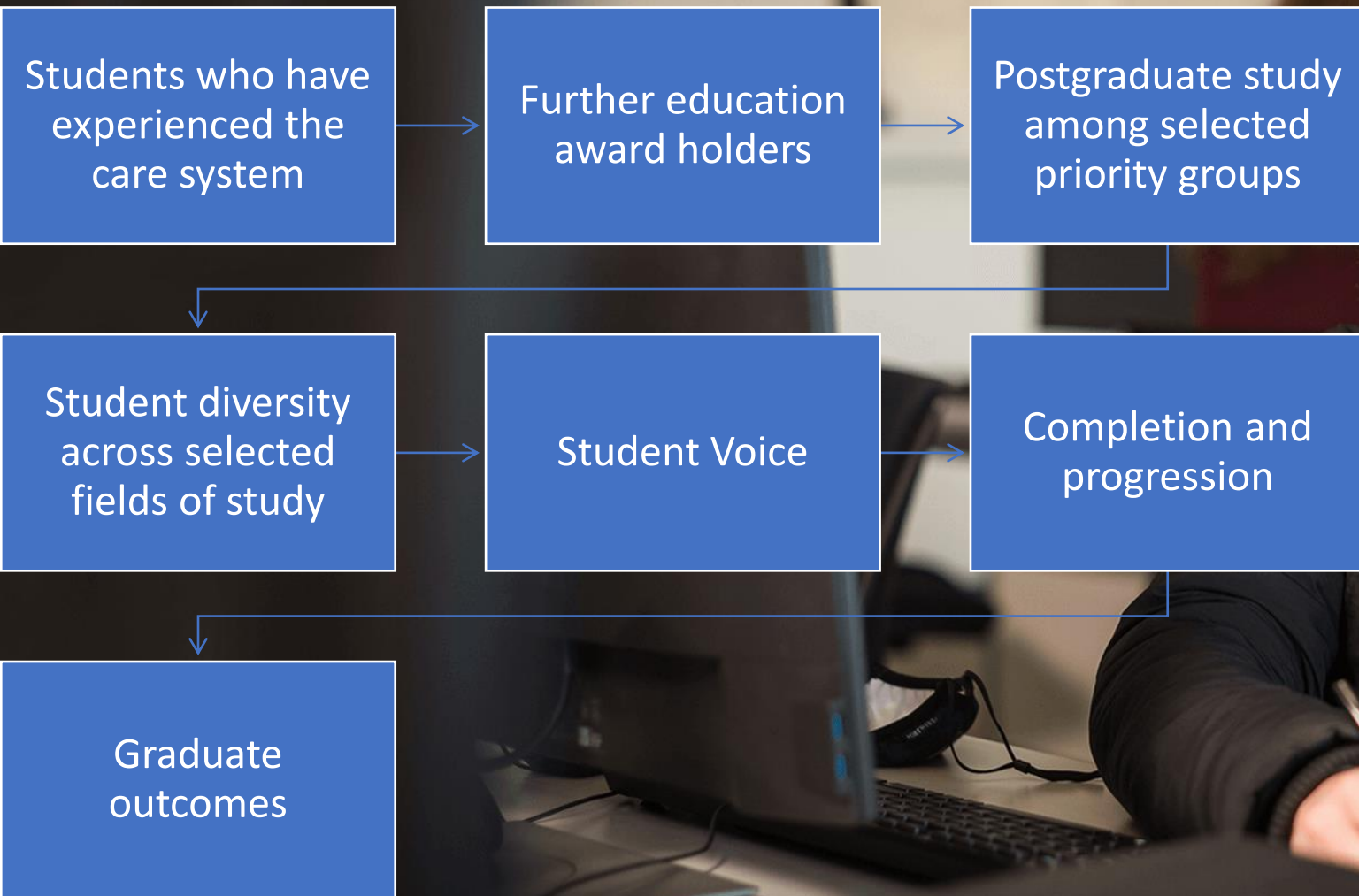
