# REVIEW PROCESS

(FOR PROJECTS REQUIRING REGULATORY AUTHORISATION)

- At present, the AEEC application process can take 2 to 10 months.
- The HPRA application process can take up to 12 weeks (expedited review possible for a fee).
- In addition to the Project Authorisation all individuals listed must be individually authorised and trained.

### 1.CURRENT FORMS DOWNLOADED

### 2. AEEC APPLICATION SUBMITTED

Email Part A (HPRA), Part B (AEEC), Project Protocol, NTPS, Score Sheet (if relevant) to <u>AEEC@ucc.ie</u> before monthly deadline.



# 3. APPLICATION RECEIVED & LOGGED

Application # assigned
Applicant notified by email
Application sent to AWB, DV and AEEC
(assigned to 2 peer reviewers + statistician).



# 4. MONTHLY AEEC IN PERSON MEETING

Primary reviewer collates comments from peer reviewers, statistician, AWB, DV, lay member and biosafety officer, sends comments to AEEC Admin.



# 5. AEEC/AWB REVIEW SENT TO APPLICANT

AEEC Admin sends anonymous comments to applicant (1-2weeks after AEEC meeting)
Applicant emails response to AEEC Admin within 3 weeks.



# 6. RESPONSE AND EDITS REVIEWED

Primary reviewer coordinates review of response/edits, sends further comments or approval to AEEC Admin.



### 7. AEEC APPROVAL GRANTED

AEEC chair and statistician sign approval letter AEEC Admin emails approval to applicants.



#### 8. HPRA APPLICATION

Applicant emails all required documents to BSUAdmin@ucc.ie
BSU Admin submits documents to HPRA.



#### 9. HPRA REVIEW

HPRA reviews application and sends comments to applicants within 40 business days.
HPRA issues Project Authorisation.
