The Coastal and Offshore Modelling symposium will take place in the Aula Maxima, Main Quadrangle, University College Cork (UCC) Campus, College Road, Cork.

## Transportation

### **Bus Services:**

*Several local bus routes in Cork serve UCC, with stops near the campus entrances:*

- **No 205:** *Rossa Avenue C.I.T. – UCC (College Road) – Dyke Parade – Washington Street – St. Patrick Street – Parnell Place Bus Station / MacCurtain St – Kent*
- *Train Station (every 15 mins)*
- **No 208:** *Curraheen (Marymount Hospice) – Bishopstown – City Centre (St. Patrick Street) – Mayfield – Ashmount – Lotabeg (every 10 mins during daytime)*
- **No 220 / 220X:** *Ovens – Ballincollig – Model Farm Rd – UCC Western Rd – City Centre – Douglas – Carrigaline – Crosshaven (every 15mins during daytime, 220X every 60mins.*
- **Taxis:** *Readily available around the campus and city centre. Popular taxi services include Cork Taxi Co-op (+353 (0)21 427 2222) and ABC Taxis (+353 (0)21 496 1961).*
- **Biking:** *Cork offers a public bike rental system, and there are bike racks available throughout the campus.*
- **On foot:** *All venues are accessible on foot.*
