

UCC FOOD Heritage in Action Course

Step-by-Step Guide to Registration

Please note there are two distinct parts to joining the course:

Part 1 Create an Account and Course Payment

- During the registration process, you will be asked to create an account.
- Once the account is created, you will be asked to pay for the course.
- Once payment is made and you are enrolled, you will be asked to confirm your account via the email provided when creating your account.

Part 2 Getting Set-up on the digital learning platform, CANVAS


- As a student for the duration of the course, you will have access to a Virtual Learning Environment (VLE). We use CANVAS as our learning platform. Here we will upload and store course materials, readings and course recordings.
- We require at the application stage that you also set-up for access to CANVAS.
- Once your payment is processed you will receive two emails that facilitate setting you up on CANVAS- follow the steps below to guide you through the process.


