UCC Study Abroad Opportunities outside the EU – Partner Institutions & Networks

- The partners below are for **studies only** during your 3rd year of a 4-year undergraduate degree
- Students interested in carrying out their **research placement** at a university outside the EU need to talk to their own UCC department directly.
- The list of universities can **change** each year so there is no guarantee that the university you want will still be available when you apply in 2nd year

- Application **deadline** approx. December of your 2nd year
- Students must meet **minimum grade requirements** to apply for partners outside the EU **Click here to learn more:** [How do I apply? | University College Cork](#)
- The number of **exchange places** available in each university vary each year
- The students' grades, UCC degree, suitability and number of exchange places available will be considered when **allocating students** to host universities.
- We ask that students are **open-minded** as we may allocate you a university not listed on your application due to places filling up or not suitable for your studies.
- Non-EU partnerships are a combination of **subject-based** agreements and **university-wide** agreements

Subject based agreements:

- Only students from the subject listed can apply for that university

University wide agreements:

- Open to all UCC students provided that university offers suitable courses to exchange students in relation to your UCC degree
- You will be asked to submit your list of modules so it is extremely important you research the module offerings correctly.

What I need to know about studying outside the EU

- Check that you have met the minimum grade requirements before you list it on your application (these are non-negotiable)
- Consider your budget (there is no funding or scholarships available)
- Upon your research of your university, it is very common for some subject areas to be **CLOSED** to exchange students. This information may not be clear on their website.
- You must check that the university offers suitable modules that cover your academic requirements set out by your UCC academic coordinator.

3. UCC nominates you to the **AEN** committee. This committee then place you in one of your top 3 choices

Scholarship Value

University of Maine Tuition Fees covered by the University of Maine
Room & Board (meal plan) covered by the University of Maine

Eligibility

- You must be a current UCC student
- You must be at least 18 years of age
- Open to students studying abroad during 3rd year of a 4-year UCC degree
- Irish citizenship

Must demonstrate:

- High academic achievement at UCC
- Leadership & commitment to community service

Students are required to pay their normal UCC fees while abroad

About the Scholarship

In recognition of the historic role of George J. Mitchell in advancing security, hope, and opportunity for generations in Ireland and Northern Ireland, the **George J. Mitchell Peace Scholarship** has been established.

The purpose of the Scholarship is to create opportunities for the exchange of university students between Ireland and the State of Maine.

University College Cork has been nominated by the Minister for Education and Science to send suitably qualified students under the Scholarship to an institution within the **University of Maine System**.

The successful candidate will receive remission of UMaine tuition fees, as well as free room and board, from the University of Maine.
