Steps for applying to study abroad.



- **Step 1** Research where you would like to go (Host university must offer suitable modules to exchange students- Student's responsibility to research)
- **Step 2** Apply by completing the application form on our website (You must be currently in 2nd year)
- **Step 3** The International Office will review your application and let you know of the outcome.
- **Step 4** Speak with your UCC academic coordinator about the modules you will be taking at the host university. They must approve them.
- Step 5- You must attend information sessions held by the International Office
- **Step 6** Complete the host university's application form (This will take place after UCC nominate you to the host university)

Requirements:

- You must be a **2nd year student**, registered for a four-year degree at UCC and you are only permitted to study abroad during your **3rd year** of your undergraduate.
- Students are not permitted to study abroad at an exchange partner whilst on a year out.
- Students can only study at a UCC exchange partner university
- Your 1st year and 1st semester of 2nd year exam results will be reviewed.
- Some degree programmes such as Maths and Engineering require students to achieve a 2.1 in both 1st year and 1st semester of 2nd year (AND maintain it for 2nd year)
- BEES Students: Students must achieve an overall grade of 65% or more in both 1st year and 2nd year at UCC
- Studying outside the EU (US/CANADA/SINGAPORE):
 - You must have at least an overall grade of 2.1 (60%) in both first year and first semester of 2nd year to qualify
- School of Asian Studies: Please check with them for their academic requirements
- Latin America: Please check with your coordinator for academic requirements
- The host university you list on your application <u>must</u> offer modules suitable for your degree. It is the responsibility of the student to research this **before** applying.
- You must also get approval from your UCC academic coordinator to study abroad
- Your degree/school/department may have additional requirements
