

Visas and Immigration

Students flying into Ireland with a passport from the **US, Canada, Japan, Singapore and Mexico** are currently not required to apply for a study visa to enter Ireland but do need to **register with immigration** (€300) after arrival to Ireland.

How do I register with immigration?
