2. A Research Proposal – This should outline, as precisely as possible, a topic on which you propose to write a dissertation. It should define a problem, develop hypotheses concerning the problem, show the theoretical framework within which the problem and the hypotheses are formulated, and indicate the method(s) which you will apply. While the research proposal will be important in the evaluation of the applicant's ability, and the Department's capacity to offer supervision on the applicant's proposed topic of research, successful applicants will be free to modify and alter their research interests in accordance with the knowledge gained and new perspectives encountered in the duration of their studies.
