Entrants to the Master of Accounting (MAcc) programme must:

- 1) Have a minimum result of Second-Class Honours, Grade I, in a degree with a significant accounting specialisation; and
- 2) Must qualify for exemption from the CA Proficiency 1 examination of Chartered Accountants Ireland (CAI).
