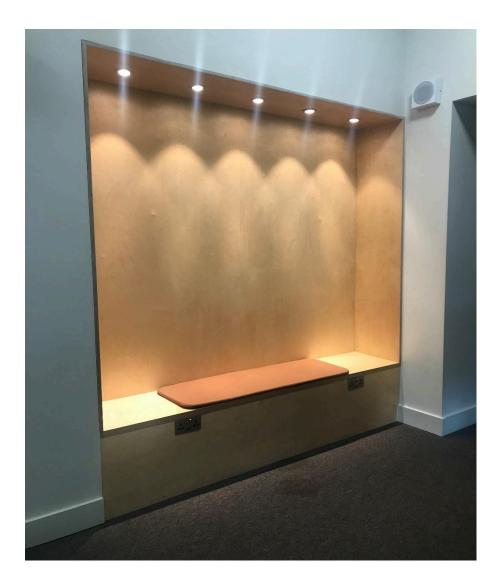
The Hub

First floor, Access Corridor, The Hub



Space A quiet bench recessed into the wall in a typically quiet corridor. There is artificial lighting overhead and sockets available.

How to access it: When you come out of the lifts take the door on your left and turn right. Before you reach the Shtepps it is on your right.

The Global Lounge, First Floor, The Hub



Space: The high back chairs in the global lounge can be moved and placed facing the window or wall to create a private space for you to sit. Depending on the time of day the global lounge may be busy and can be a noisy environment but moving the chair to a place that suits you can create a chill space. There is a small kitchenette available in this space where you can heat up your lunch or make tea.

How to access it: When you come out of the lifts, take the door on your right and the global lounge is at the end of the walkway on your right.

Student Life Space, Third Floor, The Hub





Space: The high back chairs in the student life space can create a private space with lots of natural light. There are sockets under the tables which can be used. Depending on the time of day the space may be used by other students, however, it is a small space that can only accommodate a small number of students.

How to access it: When you come out of the lifts the space is through the door on your right.

How to access it: When you enter the library turn right and it is located next to the creative zone. It requires swipe access. Please speak to your advisor to inquire about this space.

Who can access it: Approved DSS students.

Sleep Pod, Q+3, The Boole Library



Space: On Q+3 in the library there is a sleep pod. The Sleep Pod or Energy Pod is a reclining chair where you can either relax or nap for up to 20 minutes. The control panel is on the inside of the arm of the chair and you can pull around the privacy visor to block out distractions. You can plug in headphones to listen to music. There are storage areas beside the seat inside the pod where you can store your belongings. The red and green status lights at the back show if the unit is free (green light) and how long it will be occupied (red light flashing).

How to access it: Located on Q+3 in the library.

Contemplative Spaces

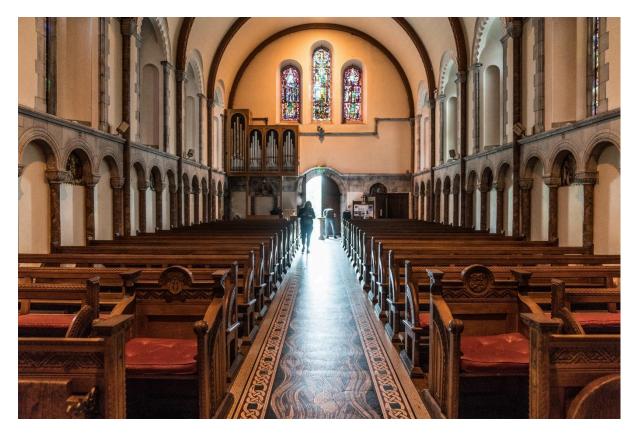
Meditation room, Chaplaincy, College Road



Space: On the top floor of the chaplaincy building there is a meditation room with chairs and meditation cushions. This space has natural light. The space can be used by other students, however, it is a small space that can only accommodate a small number of students.

How to access it: The third floor of the chaplaincy building. When you enter the building, take the stairs all the way to the top.

The Honan Chapel, Main Campus

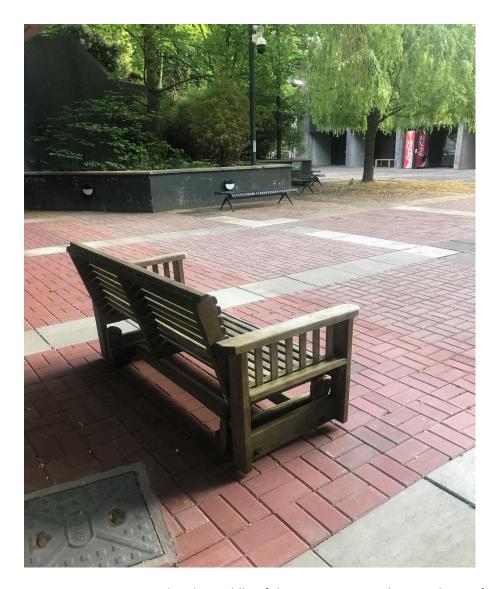


Space: The church has pews for seats and stained glass windows. The space is busier when there are masses on.

How to access it: Located next to the student centre on the main campus.

Outdoor Spaces

The Courtyard, Boole Lecture Theatres



Space: A quiet courtyard in the middle of the main campus. There is plenty of space but limited seating here, there are some benches with no backs and one wooden rocking chair. The space is surrounded by buildings.

How to access it: turn right at the bottom of the stairs or lifts in the Boole lecture theatres and follow the signs for lecture theatre 4. Exit through the external doors here.

Grassy Amphitheatre, Students Union

Space: A grassy amphitheatre with tiered seating. This space has some tree cover.



How to access it: Directly across from the Students Union building.

Who can access it: Everyone. There is a small lip in places to access the area, however, other areas are flush between the grass and path.

River View, Lower Grounds





Space: A quiet walkway along the river with views of UCC on one side and a wildflower meadow on the other. There are multiple benches or grassy patches to sit along this walk. There are open areas or more shady areas.

How to access it: From the main gates of UCC take a right at the Glucksman Art Gallery and walk along the lower grounds until you meet the bridge. There are seats on both sides of the bridge.

Bench seating in grassy area, Food Science Building



Space: Large grassy area between the food science building and Áras Na Laoi with space to sit on the floor or on the long wooden benches.

How to access it: Can be accessed from Gaol Walk. Walk straight through the Kane and cross the road at Gaol Walk. You briefly enter the building to access the outdoor area.

Outdoor Marquees, Various Locations



Space: Large covered marquees with picnic benches are located throughout the campus (one near the student centre, one at the Hub and one outside the food sciences building. The one outside the food sciences building is typically a quieter space.

How to access it: Various locations. The pictured marquee can be accessed from Gaol Walk. Walk straight through the Kane and cross the road at Gaol Walk. You briefly enter the building to access the outdoor area.

Philosophy Garden, College Road



Space: In front of the philosophy building on college road there is a small philosophy garden. There is unkept grass, wildflowers and a stone garden. There are two double benches hidden from college road by a large tree that face the garden and the building.

How to access it: Take the steps from the Boole lecture theatres up to college road. The philosophy building is on the opposite side of college road.

River View, Western Gateway Building





Space: Along the side and at the back of the Western Gateway Building there is a path by the river that has benches and a large green area.

How to access it: From the car park facing the building the river is on the left. The path runs along the river on the left side of the building and the grassy patch is at the back of the building

Brookfield and Western Gateway Buildings

Clinical Therapies Corridor, Second Floor



Space: Two couches located in an open hallway. There is some natural light through a small window and artificial lighting.

How to access it: Take the lift to the second floor and the hallway will be straight in front of you.

Window tables, School of Medicine.





Space: On the first and second floor of the school of medicine there are tables located at the window view.

How to access it: Take the lift to the first or second floor, walk straight into the room ahead of you and take the corridor to your right for the school of medicine.

Break out space, first floor, Western Gateway Building



Space: On the first floor of western gateway building, approximately half way down the corridor there is a breakout space with wooden benches. There are a few plugs in the area.

How to access it: Half way down the first floor corridor of western gateway building.

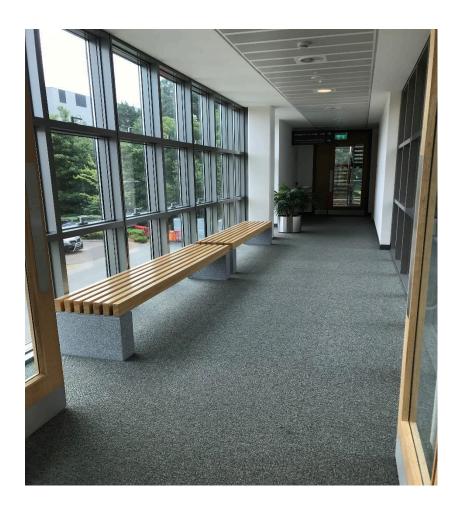
Large Couch, Second Floor, Western Gateway Building



Space: On the second floor of western gateway building, approximately halfway down the corridor there is a breakout space with a large couch.

How to access it: Halfway down the second floor corridor of western gateway building.

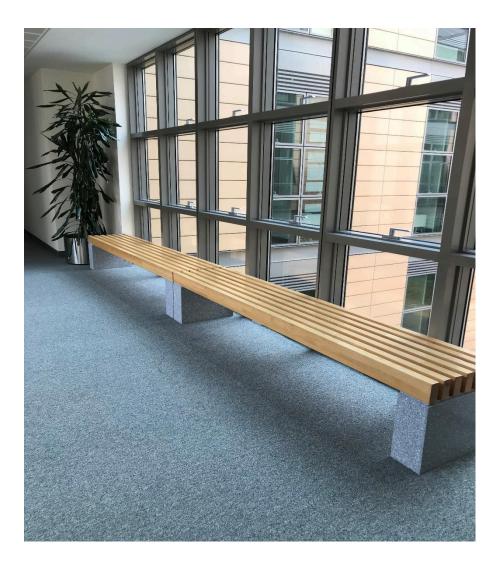
Benched window seat, first floor, western gateway building.



Space: Long wooden bench along the window at the front of the building facing out to the car park. There is plenty of natural light in this area.

How to access it: On the first floor of western gateway building, outside the school of mathematical sciences reception, at the front of the building (view of the car park)

Space: Long wooden bench along the window in the middle of the building facing out to a courtyard. There is plenty of natural light in this area.

How to access it: On the first floor of western gateway building, outside the school of computer science reception, in the middle of the building.
