

New Degree Programme 2019/2020

CK412 Agricultural Science. UCC's Bachelor of Agricultural Science has a unique dairy production focus. It provides students with a strong foundation in the core scientific, economic and sustainability principles underpinning technical efficiency and sustainability principles in Irish pasture-based dairy production. Delivered by UCC in partnership with Teagasc Moorepark, this course promises a welldefined, comprehensive and relevant curriculum. Teagasc Moorepark is internationally recognised as a Centre of excellence for grass based dairy research.

Modules will be delivered by experts in Grassland, Animal Nutrition, Breeding, Reproduction, Animal Health, Production Systems, Business Structures, Soil Science and Dairy Farm Infrastructure.

New Leaving Certificate Subject (Computer Science) 2019

The College of Science, Engineering and Food Science will now recognise Computer Science as a Leaving Certificate subject where the additional requirement for entry specifies a H4. The revised additional requirement heading should now read 'H4 in a Laboratory Science subject, or Maths or Applied Maths or Computer Science'. This will apply to students who complete their Leaving Cert in 2020.
