### RELATED PROCEDURE

Applicants who have previously been unsuccessful in any Medicine programme are deemed not to be “in good standing” and will only be considered for admission to UCC’s Medicine programmes on a case-by- case application basis, to be considered by the relevant Programme Board. Applicants should write to the Head of the Undergraduate Admissions Office, setting out why their application should be considered, along with details of any extenuating circumstances.
