Terms of Reference

The Space Sub-Committee reports to UMT(O). Its terms of reference are:

- To establish space allocation policy
- To ensure optimum utilisation and a fair distribution of space across the campus
- To assess and make recommendations on space requests
- To undertake space audits as required
- To encourage optimum utilisation of space
- To review reports for Room Booking on utilisation/monitoring etc.
- To consider space allocation in new Capital Projects.
- To make recommendations on the allocation of space as space becomes available through the completion of capital projects or in newly acquired (purchased or rented) properties.
- To send reports to UMT(O) for adoption

Membership

- Registrar and Senior Vice President Academic (Chair)
- Heads of College (or Nominee)
- Director of Buildings & Estates
- Vice President for Research
- Vice President for Student Experience
- President Students Union
- Secretary to Committee Administrative Manager, Buildings & Estates

The Committee may invite additional members as required to inform decision making.

Principles Underlying Management of University Space

- 1. Space is owned by University, not by individual Colleges/Schools/Departments/Units etc.
- 2. Space is allocated based on need at the time and is subject to ongoing review.
- 3. The Buildings and Estates Office is responsible for the management and implementation of overall University space.
- 4. The Heads of College/Senior Officers have overall responsibility for the efficient utilisation of the space allocated to the College/Unit. The Head of College/Senior Officer may devolve the day to day allocation of space within the College/Unit to the Head of individual academic/administrative units. Space/change of use requests from academic units must be through the relevant Head of College and from other units through the relevant Senior Officer.
