Work Placement

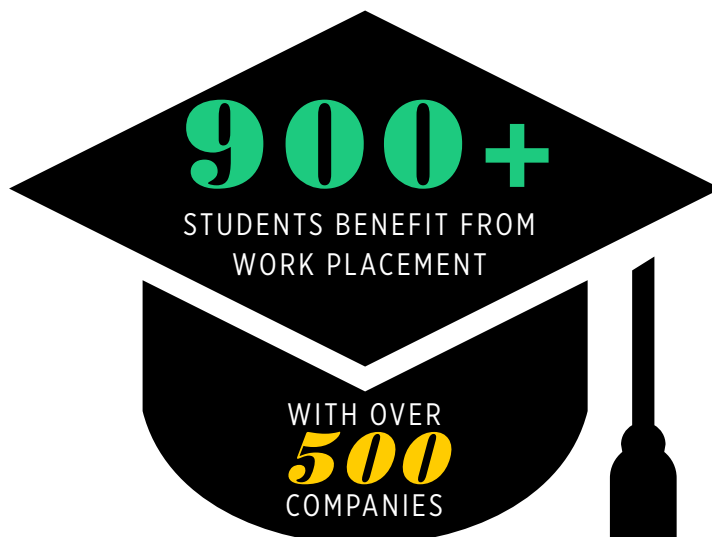
Work Placement is a partnership between the University, the employer and the student. It gives students the opportunity to gain practical work experience relevant to their course and offers the following benefits to employers:

- A range of vacancies that recruit from multiple courses

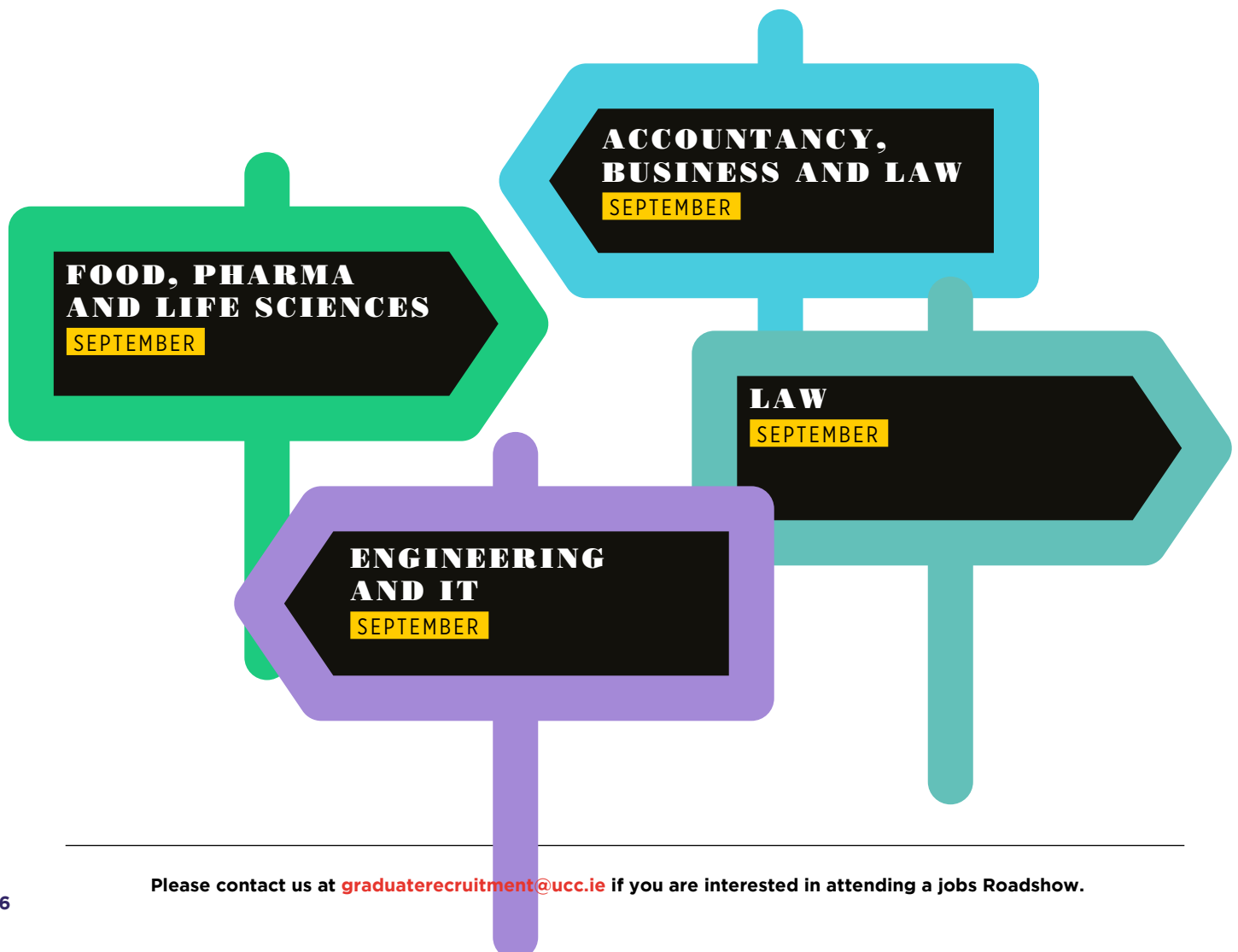


Job Roadshows

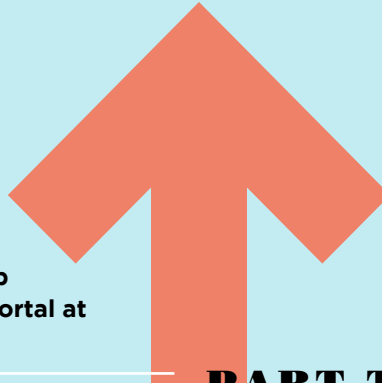

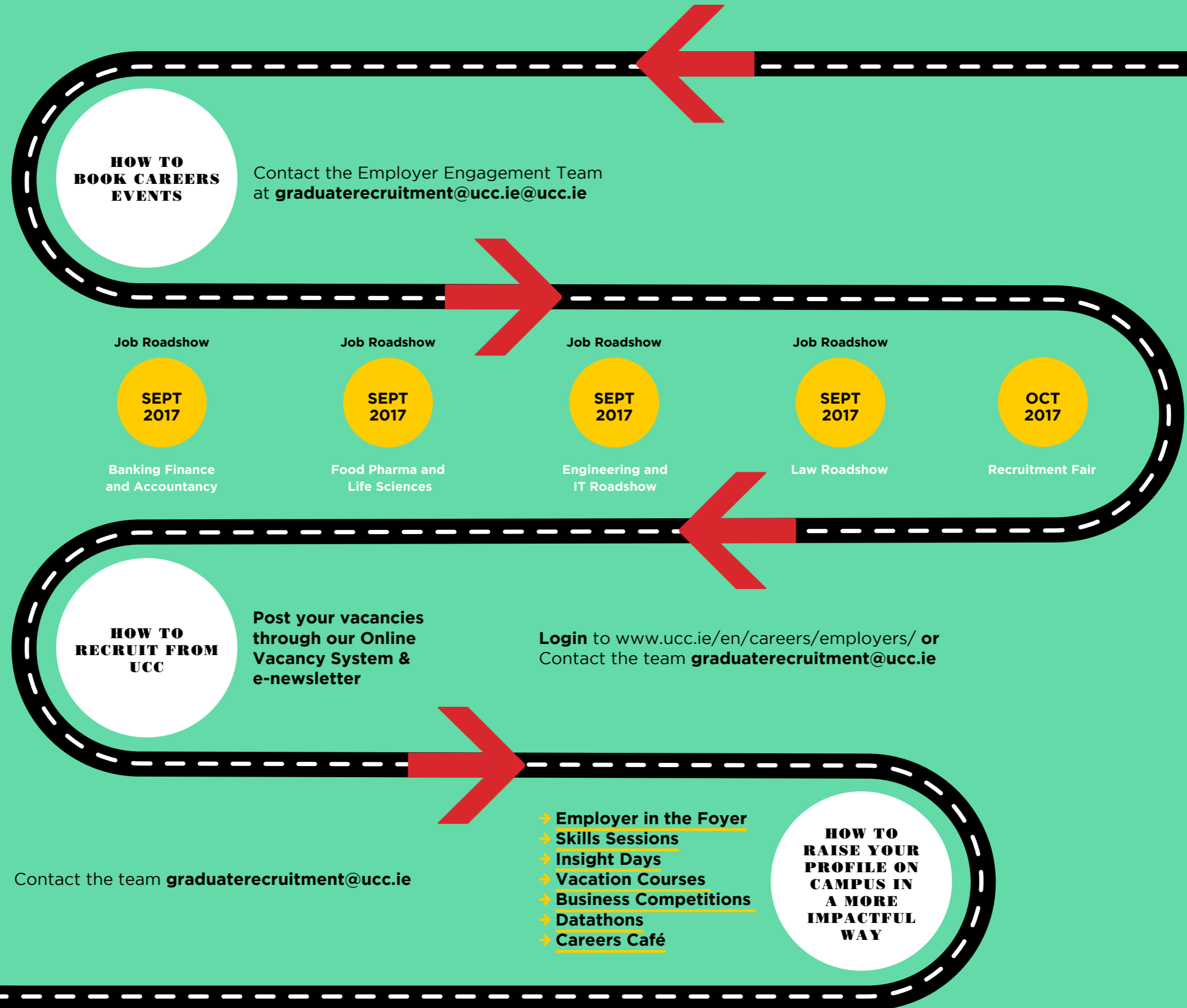
