# The Work Placement Process Employers' Roadmap

Recruitment runs throughout the academic year and is coordinated by the UCC Career Services Placement Team.



## 1. Send us a Job Description

Your job description should contain a brief outline of the role and the candidate specification. Once received it is advertised via our Work Placement Portal to all relevant students.



## 2. Students Apply for the Role

Students select the role(s) they are interested in and apply through the UCC Work Placement Portal.



## 3. CVs are Sent to Employers

Employers review CVs of interested students.



## 4. Employers Shortlist, Interview & Select

Employers select the student(s) of their choice and an offer is made through the Placement Manager.



## 5. Student Accepts Offer

Student accepts the first offer of placement. Employer liaises directly with students regarding the contract.
