PhD Walsh Fellowship Opportunity

“Increasing Milking Efficiency through application of Automation and Optimisation techniques”

Reference; WF 2018035

Background

The goal of this project is to improve the milking process efficiency of Irish dairy farms and reduce farmer working hours through the application of appropriate labour saving technologies and management strategies as determined by optimisation modelling techniques. Both conventional milking parlours and robotic milking systems will be analysed and methods of improving existing configurations using improved automatic mechanisation and optimisation will be trialled.

New scientific methods will be applied to further our understanding of the impact of management strategies and automation on milking process efficiencies. Furthermore, optimisation and cost benefit analysis will be applied to the problem of limited labour availability on Irish dairy farms, which will be interfaced with a user friendly on-line portal where farmers can assess options specific to their farm situation.

The work programme of the student will involve a blend of course-work, experimental design, modelling, data collection, data analysis, prototyping automatic systems and networking with experts in the field. The candidate will also have the opportunity to identify the practical implications of their research results on dairy farm management and will have the opportunity to speak at international scientific and farm management conferences.

Requirements

The candidate should be highly self-motivated with proven abilities in problem solving and data analysis. Applicants should have a primary degree (first or second class honours) in an appropriate discipline (Agricultural, Energy, Process, Mechanical, Biosystems, Biomedical, Computer, Civil or other suitable Engineering disciplines). A Masters degree would be an advantage but not essential. Experience of design/modelling/statistical software and data analysis would be an advantage. Prior knowledge of the dairy industry and/or the milking process is desirable but not essential. The candidate must be highly proficient in both written and spoken English. A full driving licence is required.

Award

This PhD Fellowship is a joint research project between Teagasc Moorepark and Cork Institute of Technology. The successful candidate must be willing to travel between the Teagasc Research Centre at Moorepark, Co. Cork, Ireland and Cork Institute of Technology to accomplish both academic and research objectives. The successful candidate will be registered at Cork Institute of Technology. The fellowship will commence as soon as possible after 1st October 2018.

The Fellowship provides a stipend of €22,000 per year, for 4 years, for student subsistence and institutional fees. Auxiliary funds will be available for the student to allocate toward international travel and continued professional development.

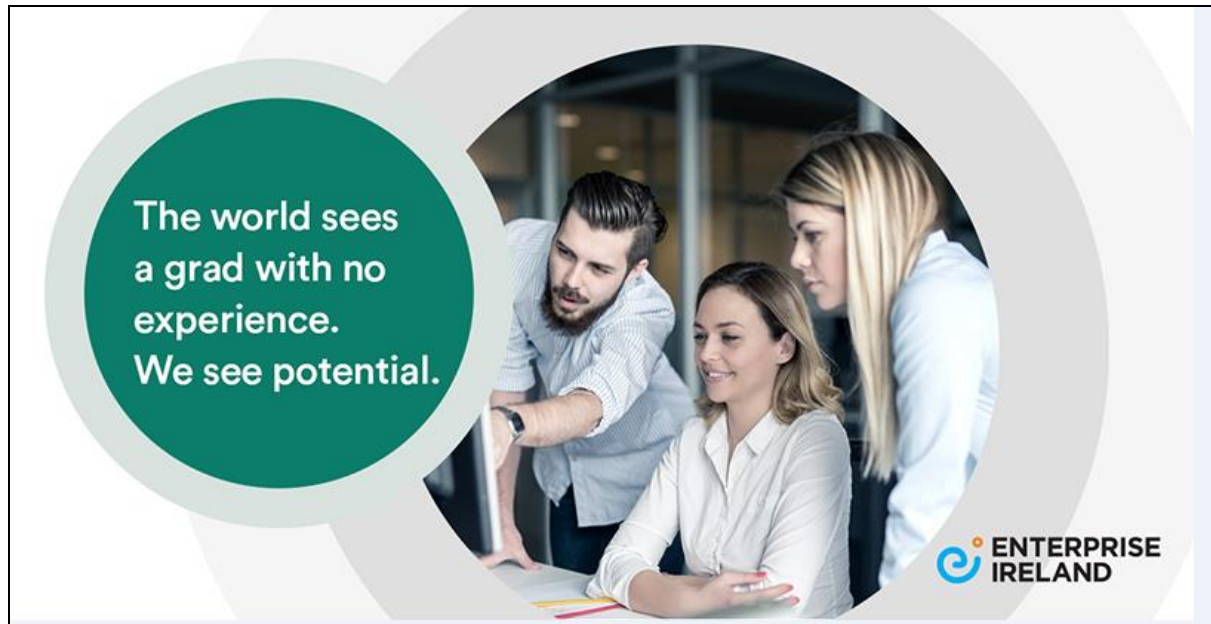
