

# The Work Placement Process

## Employers' Roadmap

Recruitment runs throughout the academic year and is coordinated by Placement Managers

### 01. Send us a Job Description

The Job Description contains a brief description of the role and the candidate specification and is circulated to all students.



### 02. Students Apply for the Role

Students select the role(s) they are interested in and apply through the Placement Manager.

### 03. CVs are Sent to Employers

Employers review CVs of interested students.



### 04. Employers Shortlist, Interview & Select

Employers select the student(s) of their choice and an offer is made through the Placement Manager.

### 05. Student Accepts Offer

Students accept the first offer of placement. Employer liaises directly with students regarding the contract.
