Employers' Roadmap

Recruitment runs throughout the academic year and is coordinated by Placement Managers

01. Send us a Job Description

The Job Description contains a brief description of the role and the candidate specification and is circulated to all students.



02. Students Apply for the Role

Students select the role(s) they are interested in and apply through the Placement Manager.

03. CVs are Sent to Employers

Employers review CVs of interested students.



04. Employers Shortlist, Interview & Select

Employers select the student(s) of their choice and offer is made through Placement Manager.



05. Student Accepts Offer

Students accept the first offer of placement. Employer liaises directly with students regarding the contract.
