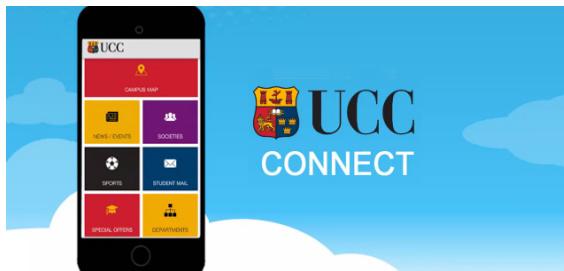


Welcome!
