





Applying for Funding

- Identify opportunities:
 - Keep an eye out for our weekly funding roundup email Wednesday Afternoons
 - Checkout our Open Funding Calls SharePoint page
 - Contact UCC Research to meet with one of us about funding options
- When you have a grant call identified, contact UCC Research at the earliest opportunity
- Submit application in plenty of time!

All funding applications must be signed off by UCC Research Submit draft application & budget to UCC Research a minimum <u>5 working days</u> in advance of call deadline



Congratulations on your Award – What Next?

Goal: Get a research account opened and get the project underway

A. All research contracts/agreements must be reviewed before they can be signed and a research account opened.

B. The following documentation should be made available to the relevant Research Support Administrator (RSA):

- Submitted Application
- **Contract Assessment Form (Appendix C):**This document must be signed you (and any co-PIs), your Head of Unit, and the relevant Head of College
- Contract documentation from the Funding Agency
- Patient-focussed Questionnaire (PFQ)


The RSA will work with the relevant University Offices to coordinate the review of your contract/agreement
