About Us



Our Vision - UCC connects and empowers people to create knowledge that shapes a sustainable and inclusive world.


Our Mission - UCC's mission is to create and sustain an inclusive environment and culture to enable transformative research and learning for the enrichment of society and stewardship of our planet.
