Catherine Cronin – independent open scholar Title: Higher Education towards 2030: what stories do we tell (ourselves) about who we are? Abstract: In the context of the current global polycrisis, it is clear that the assumptions and foundations of higher education are under threat. As vital as we believe our work in higher education to be - for our students, for wider society, and for the future - we face enormous challenges across all of our respective roles. Yet, as Freire (1994) reminds us, if we succumb to fatalism, "it becomes impossible to muster the strength we absolutely need for a fierce struggle that will re-create the world" (p.8). Drawing on work by scholars from a wide range of disciplines and HE contexts globally, including Higher Education for Good (Czerniewicz & Cronin, 2023), this keynote will explore current challenges, responses, and visions for the future of higher education. What stories do we tell ourselves about who we are – and what stories might we tell?
