# ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

## UCC OWNED CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION

There are five complexes available to first year students in Campus Accommodation

- Victoria Lodge • Victoria Mills • Castlewhite
- Mardyke Hall • University Hall

## APPLICATIONS FOR CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION

- You must live over 45km from UCC
- Applications open for one month only (normally Feb - March each year)
- Applications received are included in a **Random Selection Lottery**

## RECOMMENDATIONS

Because places are not guaranteed in Campus Accommodation, we also suggest that students search for an alternative source of accommodation as a backup.

## PRIVATELY OWNED STUDENT APARTMENT COMPLEXES

- These complexes have a similar model to Campus Accommodation, but prices can vary considerably.
- There are over 6,000 beds in privately owned student apartment complexes throughout Cork City (**A full list is available on our website**)

**SINCE 2021, STUDENTS NOW HAVE THE OPTION OF PAYING MONTHLY IN STUDENT SPECIFIC ACCOMMODATION**

## PRIVATE RENTALS

- Defined as house shares with other students
- Monthly rental costs will vary based on standard and/or distance from UCC

## DIGS (OWNER OCCUPIED HOUSING)

- Living with home owner/family
- May be subject to a rental period of 5 or 7 days per week
- May include meals and/or bills
