### How Do Flashcards Work?

• Flashcards engage "active recall"

→ You need to actively engage with the material while learning with flashcards


- Flashcards engage your metacognition
- $\rightarrow$  Tells you how well you know the material (self-reflection)
- Flashcards allow for confidence-based repetition
- → The lesser-known material will be repeated more often than the well known material (spaced repetition)
- Creating the flashcards is a way of engaging with the information
- ightarrow Distilling and discerning the relevant material







- Make your own flashcards
- Mix pictures and words
- Make use of "mnemonic devices"
- One question/concept per card
- Saying answers out loud while studying (if possible)
- Study flashcards in both directions

#### The Don'ts of Flashcards



- Create cards that improve recognition instead of recall
- Use it for rote repetition
- Use them when other methods are better suited
- Make too complexe cards
